

## **President (1 seat)**

The **President** serves as the chief executive officer of the AGG USA Federation and provides overall leadership, strategic direction, and official representation of the Federation at national and international levels.

The President shall be responsible for:

- Establishing the vision and strategic priorities of the Federation in collaboration with the Board of Directors;
- Representing the AGG USA Federation in all official capacities, including interactions with the International Federation of Aesthetic Group Gymnastics (IFAGG), national sports governing bodies, and other external stakeholders;
- Ensuring that the Federation operates in full compliance with its mission statement, adopted policies, bylaws, and all applicable laws and administrative regulations;
- Providing oversight of the Board of Directors, standing committees, and Administrative Office to maintain organizational coherence and alignment with established objectives;
- Approving major initiatives, strategic partnerships, and programs designed to advance the development, promotion, and visibility of Aesthetic Group Gymnastics within the United States;
- Appointing additional board members as deemed necessary for the growth and welfare of the Federation.
- Represent The USA at International events


This is a non-term-limited position. The President shall identify and propose successor candidates and provide support for a smooth transition of leadership.

## **Vice President (1-3 seats, subject to approval by the President)**

The **Vice President(s)** assist the President in accomplishing the objectives of the AGG USA Federation and may act in the President's stead when authorized or required.

The Vice President(s) shall be responsible for:

- Supporting strategic planning and the implementation of Federation initiatives;

- 
- Facilitating coordination and effective communication among the Board of Directors, committees, and Administrative Office;
  - Serving as liaison for special projects, programs, or events as assigned by the President;
  - Assuming the full duties and authority of the President in their absence to ensure continuity of leadership and decision-making;
  - Providing counsel and assistance to the President and the Board to promote sound governance and effective operational oversight;
  - Collaborating with the President to ensure that all Federation activities comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and internal policies.

These are non-term-limited positions. The President shall identify and propose successor candidates and provide support for a smooth transition of leadership.

### **Secretary (1 seat)**

The **Secretary** serves as the official custodian of records and ensures proper documentation, notice, and communication in support of effective governance.

The Secretary shall be responsible for:

- Recording and maintaining accurate minutes of all meetings of the Board of Directors and, as applicable, committees;
- Providing timely and proper notice of all Board and committee meetings in accordance with the bylaws and applicable law;
- Preparing and distributing meeting agendas, supporting materials, and other documents as required;
- Maintaining the official corporate records and governance documents of the Federation, including (but not limited to) articles of incorporation, bylaws, board resolutions, conflict-of-interest disclosures, IRS determination letter, and historical records;
- Facilitating effective communication and information flow among Board members, committees, staff, and other stakeholders.

This position carries a **three (3)-year term**, renewable at the discretion of the seat holder.

## **AGG USA Technical Committee (4 seats)**

The **AGG USA Technical Committee** holds primary authority over technical standards, competition rules, and the General Manual (GM) for Aesthetic Group Gymnastics in the United States.

The Technical Committee is responsible for:

- Approving the General Manual and any proposed amendments thereto. The Committee may propose changes to the GM at any time. All approvals of the GM or amendments shall be announced on the official AGG USA website ([www.aggusafederation.com](http://www.aggusafederation.com));
- Establishing, maintaining, and updating AGG competition rules, regulations, appendices, and official interpretations applicable to events held in the United States. Major changes shall be approved by the Committee and published on the AGG USA website, taking effect no earlier than one week following announcement and validation;
- Verifying compliance of all participating teams with AGG USA event requirements, including review of team rosters via the KSIS system following registration deadlines;
- Exercising final decision-making authority on all matters referenced in the adopted rules and regulations, unless such authority has been expressly delegated to another body or individual.

All members of AGG USA—including clubs, coaches, judges, athletes, and committees—are bound to comply with the rules, regulations, and decisions of the Technical Committee. Compliance is a mandatory condition for participation in AGG USA competitions, events, and programs (IFAGG General Competition Rules, p. 5).

The Technical Committee operates independently from the Board of Directors in all matters concerning the qualification system, competitions, technical rules, and the General Manual. This independence safeguards the integrity of the sport and ensures decisions are grounded in technical expertise and impartiality.

This position carries a **three (3)-year term**, renewable at the discretion of the seat holder.

## **AGG USA Ethics Committee (4 seats)**

The **Ethics Committee** upholds the principles of Fair Play as the fundamental guiding value in Aesthetic Group Gymnastics.

All participants—including gymnasts, groups, coaches, assistants, judges, managers, clubs, delegation members, and competition organizers—are required to conduct themselves with honesty, good sportsmanship, courtesy, and respect at all times. Any disturbance of other participants during

performances or intentional misleading of judges/officials violates the IFAGG and AGG USA codes of ethics (IFAGG General Competition Rules, p. 26).

Violations of the IFAGG Code of Ethics shall be addressed in accordance with the IFAGG and AGG USA Disciplinary Rules. Judges are obligated to adhere to all IFAGG and AGG USA regulations, including the Code of Ethics for Judges. Violations by judges shall result in sanctions per the IFAGG judges' warning procedure.

Competition organizers must manage participant personal data in compliance with applicable privacy laws, using such data solely for event organization and deleting it once no longer required (IFAGG General Competition Rules, p. 27).

This position carries a **three (3)-year term**, renewable at the discretion of the seat holder.

### **General Member (2 seats)**

**General Members** provide support to the Board of Directors in advancing the mission and operations of the AGG USA Federation.

This position carries a **three (3)-year term**, renewable at the discretion of the seat holder.

### **Member at Large (1 seat)**

The **Member at Large** must be a current club owner holding active AGG USA membership. This individual serves as the representative voice of all member clubs within the Federation.

This position carries a **one (1)-year term**, renewable at the discretion of the seat holder.

This document reflects standard governance practices for nonprofit organizations and aligns with the AGG USA Federation's commitment to compliance, transparency, and the advancement of Aesthetic Group Gymnastics in the United States. Specific duties and terms remain subject to the Federation's bylaws and any applicable amendments.
