

IFAGG JUDGING REGULATIONS 2024-2025



Part 1	Requirements for IFAGG Judging license
---------------	---

1.1	IFAGG member
1.2	Valid judging license for last 2 years (approved and paid)
1.3	New judges (IFAGG members) who pass the International judge course and exam for 3 rd level in 2023-2024-2025

Part 2	All judges who meet the requirements from Part 1 will be evaluated on the following criteria and have the right to act as an international level

2.1	Judges at a minimum of 1 international IFAGG B level competition per year

2.2	Participated (as a participant) in any IFAGG Judges course live (in present) once in every 2 years* (Level 1,2 or 3/Re-certifying/Deep Technique/Head Judge)

** For 2024 calendar year, participation in judge course in 2023 will be counted*

Part 3	Judges eligible to apply to participate at the IFAGG World Championships
---------------	---

3.1	All judges covered in Part 1 and Part 2 of these Regulations
3.2	Judges who participated in the judging panel at a minimum of 1 World Cup/ Challenge Cup/Continental championships Junior and/or Women in current year
3.3	All judges with active level 1 and level 2 licences
3.4	In Head judge position could be IFAGG judge level 1, who has participated and passed exam in Head judge course* every 2 years** (first possibilities are 2024 - January or September) *Exception – IFAGG instructors in official judges' courses **Starting from 2025 World championships

A maximum of 1 judge per country will be on each Panel (for each category, Women and Juniors). If there are more judges from same country, the Responsible judge will hold a draw. If there are less the 16 judges from different countries, the Responsible judge will make a draw for second judge from same country.

Part 5 Possible exceptions for keeping judging licenses*

**IFAGG members have to inform the IFAGG Office of any exceptions
Covered in Part 1 of the IFAGG Judging Regulations

5.1	Maternity/sickness
5.2	Position as IFAGG President and Disciplinary committee members

Criteria for keeping judging licenses in Part 5

1	Participate in national competition / IFAGG Judging course in case of maternity or sickness
2	Participate in an international IFAGG judging course during current year as a participant in the case of a Position in IFAGG

All IFAGG Judges with a valid Licence will receive

- Rights to act as international IFAGG judge in year of licence
- IFAGG Judging Certificate
- IFAGG Judging Card
- Embroidered IFAGG LOGO for Judge's Jacket

NOTE! All judges must keep their judge papers minimum 6 months after every competition and be ready to present them if needed.
