

AGG USA Prices for Sanctioned Events

1. Fees to Host an AGG USA Partner Competition to be paid by the LOC

There is no initial payment due to AGG USA to host a partner competition. In return for the guidance AGG USA provides to the LOC, \$5 per registered athlete must be paid to the AGG USA Office after the competition.

2. Fees to Host an AGG USA Invitational Competition to be paid by the LOC

Only a one-time fee is due to the AGG USA Office before the competition to host an AGG USA sanctioned invitational:

Note: Fees to host an AGG USA sanctioned event must be paid to the AGG USA office via Zelle.

3. Registration Fees for athletes

The registration fee for all participating athletes is \$95 per athlete for each event that they participate in. If the event is IFAGG sanctioned, then the competition must follow the IFAGG registration fees listed [here](#).



4. Ticket prices

| | Per day | Two-day Pass |
|---|-------------|--------------|
| If the AGG USA sanctioned event is held with a rhythmic gymnastics event | \$25 | \$35 |
| If it is an AGG only event | \$35 | \$50 |

Note: Remember that acceptable payment methods for ticket sales must be listed on the competition invite that is posted on KSIS.

5. Judge's Compensation

Per diem:

If a judge travels out of their home city to a competition, they must be paid a per diem rate as listed by the U.S. General Services Administration [here](#). This is in addition to their hourly rate.

Hourly rate:

The hourly rate for AGG USA judges is \$30 per hour. If a competition takes place and it is less than three hours per day, then the daily rate for that competition is \$90 per day.

Note: Judges must be paid before the second day of competition ends.
